SECURITY

BEFORE USE, CHECK:

- Module in low position (wheel system not engaged)
- Nothing placed on the module
- The module must be at least 1.83 M from the wall of the parkour room.
- The module must be at least 2.1 M from another module (wood or metal) for the 2 M modules and 1.4 M for the modules of less than 1 M.
- Check the condition of the Assembly Key components.
- Check that the Assembly Key of the modules are properly in place in the holes provided for this purpose.
- Ensure that the module lifting handle is not in the lock.
- When using metal bars (Handrails) check that the key and the wheels are securely in place in the holes provided for this purpose.
- That a competent person be present when using the module.
- We recommend the use of parkour or gym mats be in place around the module in case of falls.

USE OF BARS (HANDRAILS):

In compliance with the European Parkour standard, ensure that there is always **an empty hole between each bar**, both horizontally and vertically. See diagram <u>below</u>

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USERS:

Intended for use primarily by users aged 8 and over. Equipment should be used in line with the users own sporting abilities.

FALLS:

The fall space around the modules must be clear, only other modules, bars or mats should be present and within safe distances.

STORAGE:

Store the equipment in a clean, dry place, away from humidity and heat. Do not store anything heavy, protruding or otherwise with the modules. When disassembling the modules, avoid direct contact with the ground. Modules can be stored safely on top of each other. The modules can be used indoors but also outdoors but can never be stored outdoors.

WARNING:

This equipment should be used by one person at a time and under the supervision of a qualified person. Use of this equipment for purposes other than those initially planned is excluded.

DAMAGES OR ANOMALIES:

In the event of a noted or presumed anomaly, do not use the equipment until a technician has intervened. - Any damaged or deformed element must be replaced as soon as possible.

SURVEILLANCE:

We recommend the practice of parkour under the supervision of a competent person to supervise the layout and respect for the safety of users. Separation from other facilities and activities — Parkour equipment should be separated from children's play facilities.
